Railroading Merit Badge Workshop

Saturday, April 2, 2011
9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Learn about modern freight trains and passenger trains in this exciting workshop. Use a timetable to plan a trip by rail, learn about railroad company operations and opportunities, discuss the importance of railroad signal and warning devices, and hear about Operation Lifesaver and railroad safety.

- Workshop taught by employees of CSX and Genesee & Wyoming railroad companies.
- One adult chaperon admitted free for every five Scouts registered (1:5 ratio). Additional adults pay regular museum admission.
- Space is limited. Siblings are not permitted.
- Fee includes workshop materials and museum admission.
- Workshop includes a lunch break; bring a bag lunch and beverage.
- Troops are invited to stay after the workshop to explore the museum's exhibits. Workshops do not include time for free exploration of exhibits.
- Each Scout needs to bring their blue card.
- Requirements 1-7 will be completed in workshop

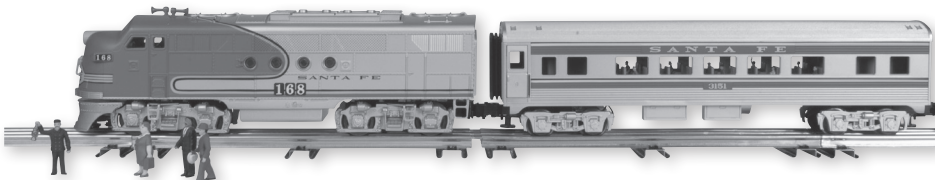
Fee: \$12 per Scout
